Also, include any pictures you may want to show me concerning field trips or projects, so I can note progress. I NEED TO SEE WORK or pictures of projects in order to write about them.
- Any quantitative data you can include (tests or graded assignments)
- Bring any questions you may have
- Payment (\$40.00 for one child and \$10.00 for each additional)
